Proposed Constructon or Alteration on or near Army Airfields and Heliports

AR 95-2 requires the Department of the Army Representative (DAR) and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) be notified of all proposed construction and/or alteration of existing structures on or near Army airfields and heliports. Facilities located outside the National Airspace System should contact USAASD–E/EUSA ATC coordinators office or HQ, USAASA for further guidance and information. TERMINAL INSTRUMENT PROCEDURES

Foreign Terminal Instrument Procedures (FTIP) Notice to Airman (NOTAM) Amending Minima

U.S. DOD FLIP publishes foreign terminal procedures according to service and NGA specifications. The DOD published minima may require an amendment to a higher value based upon a host nation B series NOTAM which increases the Obstruction Clearance Altitude/Height (OCA) (H). In no case may the host nation NOTAM be used to lower the minima that are published in DOD FLIP.

Foreign Terminal Instrument Procedures (FTIP) for Publication in DoD Flight Information Publications (FLIP) including RNAV.

1. U.S. Army Aviation Task Force, Detachment and BN Commanders having an operational need to publish FTIP's in U.S. DOD FLIP will submit a request IAW AR 95-1, chapter 5, Para 5-1b and AR 95-2, chapter 6 Para 6-8.

An operational need is defined as six IFR missions per calendar year. Training is not considered an operational need. Include alternate/emergency divert airfields used to support the primary mission destination. Include all recurring compliance review requests that are submitted on a continuous basis such as ferry flights to and from the U.S. Identify mission critical airfields that provide direct support to the COCOM, MEDEVAC, State Department and Flag officer (VIP) or any destinations that are used daily/weekly. Instructions for Downloading U.S. Army Emergency Copter Area Navigation (RNAV)/Global Positioning System (GPS) Instrument Approach Procedures (IAP)

1. Emergency COPTER RNAV instrument recovery procedures for Inadvertent Instrument Meteorological Conditions (IIMC) will only be developed when approved DOD/or U.S. Government instrument approaches in the area of operations are not available. Requests for Emergency IIMC procedures is IAW AR 95-1 Para 5-6 and must include documentation that an approved DOD or US Government procedure is not available or suitable for the aircraft equipage/certification or the risk for hazardous cargo cannot be mitigated at a civil airfield.
2. Procedures that enter civil or military controlled airspace shall be coordinated with the US Army AT&A, the servicing ATC and provided to the DAR for review prior to development, implementation and shall be documented in a Letter of Agreement/Procedure (LOA/LOP).

4. Procedures will be developed and flight inspected by the FAA and approved by USAASA for Army aircrews conducting emergency IIMC recovery. US Army Host Nation Approval List (HNAL)

U.S. Army Aviation Commanders are authorized to use the host nation instrument procedures published by countries and at airports listed in the USA-HNAL without any further processing or approval. Additionally, USAASA authorizes the use of commercial terminal instrument procedures and databases for Area Navigation and Required Navigational Performance (RNAV/RNP) OCONUS in the countries and airports in the HNAL. Use of Global Navigation System (GNSS) OCONUS in Lieu of Ground-Based NAVAIDS (GNSS Substitution)

Aircrews completing ICAO flight plan item 10 (equipment and capabilities) are documenting that the equipment is carried and serviceable aboard the aircraft. Substitution of GNSS in lieu of conventional ground based NAVAIDS may not be referenced in US DOD FLIP Area Planning (AP) documents, but may be authorized in a national Aeronautical Information Publication/Circular. (E.g. United States, AC 90-108 and/or Canada Aeronautical Information Circular 5/15). For example; if item 10 flight plan entries do not include “D” (DME) and DME is required for the approach/departure procedures to be flown, the substitution of GNSS in lieu of DME may not be assumed without additional research. The Theatre FLIP Maintenance Working Group-Europe (TFMWG-E) is currently reviewing host nation Aeronautical publications and references with an action item to update the US DOD FLIP AP series. European Command (EUCOM), African Command (AFRICOM), Middle East, Central Command (CENTCOM), and Afghanistan Area of Responsibility (AOR) Update

Frequency Modulated Immunity (FMI)

Non-FMI ILS/Localizer and VOR receiver electronics are susceptible to interference from radio and TV stations. As a result, non-FMI aircraft are subject to significant flight restrictions. An unknown number of Area Planning (AP) series entries for FMI are not correct and some host nation Aeronautical Information Publication (AIP) data regarding FMI policy exceptions may not be current. Prior to flight in non-FMI aircraft, aircrews shall contact USAASD-E for an FMI policy clarification at the destination, alternate, and emergency airfield locations. USAASD-E will review the country-specific FMI requirements and provide a response. Aviation task force or brigade deployments of multiple non-FMI aircraft shall consolidate request. Requests will include type and number of non-FMI aircraft. Units shall ensure all appropriate personnel (aircrews, planners, command and control personnel, etc.) are sufficiently trained to determine FMI equipment limitations and flight planning requirements as noted above.
